CLEAR

CONSENT IS ACTIVE, IT IS EXPRESSED THROUGH WORDS OR ACTIONS THAT CREATE PERMISSION. SILENCE IS NOT CONSENT.

COHERENT

PEOPLE INCAPACITATED BY DRUGS/ALCOHOL, SLEEPING, OR IN A VULNERABLE POSITION CANNOT GIVE CONSENT.

WILLING

CONSENT IS NEVER GIVEN UNDER PRESSURE. IT CAN NOT BE GIVEN THROUGH PSYCHOLOGICAL OR EMOTIONAL MANIPULATION AND PHYSICAL VIOLENCE.

ONGOING

CONSENT MUST BE GRANTED EVERYTIME AT EACH SET OF THE PHYSICAL INTIMACY. CONSENT ONCE, IS NOT CONSENT FOREVER, IT CAN BE REVOKED.

CONSENT
